- HAYDEN, Serjt. George Frederick Stone, 304257. 33rd Bty. 9th Bde. Canadian Field Artillery. Died of wounds, received at Petit Vimy, 17th July, 1917. Age 26. Son of Mr. F. W. and Gertrude E. Hayden (*née* Stone), of 216, Robert St., Toronto, Ontario. He was a Post Graduate of Toronto Conservatoire School of Expression. Lecturer on Oratory at Trinity College, Toronto. IV. A. 34.
- HAYES, Pte. Roy Theodore, 733843. 25th Bn. Canadian Inf. (Nova Scotia Regt.). Died of wounds, received at Vimy Ridge, 11th May, 1917. Age 20. Son of Gilbert and Georgina Hayes, of La Have, Lunenburg County, Nova Scotia. IV. B. 12.
- HAYES, Pte. Thomas Cook, 17014. 7th Bn. Canadian Inf. (British Columbia Regt.). Died of wounds, received at Ypres, 12th May, 1915. Age 27. Son of John and Elizabeth Hayes, of 19, Gilsland St., Millfield, Sunderland, England. VIII. C. 27.
- HAYTER, Pte. George Edmond, 234839. 27th Bn. Canadian Inf. (Manitoba Regt.). Died of wounds 14th April, 1917. Age 26. Son of George Nelson Hayter and Mary Hoyte Hayter, of Alameda, Saskatchewan. IV. D. 16.
- HEATH, Pte. G., 51215. P.P.C.L.I. (Eastern Ontario Regt.). Died of bronchitis 23rd March, 1915. Age 45. Son of Mr. and Mrs. G. Heath, of 95, Congregation St., Point St. Charles, Montreal. Served in Soudan Campaign. Native of Berkshire, England. III. D. 57.
