Historical notes:

The cemetery occupies 50 acres of land adjacent to the Kelowna Golf and Country Club at the base of Dilworth Mountain. Originally an Anglican Church burial ground at the turn of the century, Kelowna Memorial Park Cemetery now pays silent tribute to the many different ethnic communities whose pioneer spirit built the city. There are four First World War and 15 Second World War Commonwealth war graves in the Cemetery, the majority of which are marked with Commission upright headstones.

FROST, Staff Sergeant, BENJAMIN W., 17089, 7th Bn., Canadian Infantry (British Columbia Regiment). Died of phthisis 13 October 1919. Age 37. Son of Benjamin Ward Frost and Louisa Frost, of "Oakdene," Bishops Avenue, East Finchley, Middx., England. Grave Ref. L.9. 8.

JAMES, Lance Corporal, WALTER H., 760313, Canadian Railway Troops. Died of sickness 19 October 1919. Age 43. Son of the late William Henry and Annie James. Grave Ref. 6. 8.

McMILLAN, Private, NEIL ANGUS, 2204863, Canadian Railway Troops. Died of influenza 17 October 1918. Age 31. Son of Dan and Catherine McMillan, of Kelowna, British Columbia; husband of the late E. McMillan. Grave Ref. L.23. Row 4.
